## **Mighty Mississippi River Spring Rally Changes**

We are very excited to give you the opportunity to take a trip of a lifetime that is now completed, and all dates and times are in. We will be including all information in the newsletter for you to see what our 25 day trip will be for the May rally.

We have made a few changes to the trip that we will address with the deletions and the additions in this rally update:

1. The original Toad Suck stop for two days has had to be eliminated due to the park will not be providing RV spaces until past May 3, 2020. This was due to the major flooding last year that demolished the Corp of Engineer Park.
2. We have added an extra day in Branson Missouri at the beautiful Treasure Lake RV Resort.
3. You will also see the #1 rated show in Branson "The Haygoods Show" on Saturday night and Dolly Parton Stampede and Dinner Show now on Sunday evening.
4. We have included the lunch at the world-famous Lamberts Roll Throwing Restaurant in our price.
5. We have added the following optional venues in St. Louis to the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Louis and the Missouri History Museum.
6. In Cape Girardeau, Missouri we have added a early dinner for Mother's Day at the Port Cape Girardeau Restaurant, with plenty of time to still see the Bollinger Mill State Historic Site and the Crisp Museum.

No changes in Tunica/Memphis location.

7. In Vicksburg, Mississippi we have changed our Mansion tour to Anahuac as just a tour.
  8. We have included lunch at the famous Walnut Hills Restaurant in Vicksburg, Mississippi.
  9. We have added an optional trip to the Mississippi State Capital in Jackson Mississippi which is appx. 45 miles from Vicksburg. We will have ample time to get to the capital for a group tour.   11. Added item is a breakfast in the club house on Sunday morning prepared by your rally host of Biscuits and Sausage Gravy with fruit.
  12. We have switched Historical Home tour to the famous Stanton Mansion.
  13. We have included in the price of the rally going to Cafe Du Monde for Coffee and Beignets on Thursday evening in New Orleans.
  14. We have also included going to the one and only Mardi Gras World Museum. You will see the past floats, how they are made and the many costumes from past parades. You will receive beads and a piece of King cake.
