FRED'S TECH-TIPS



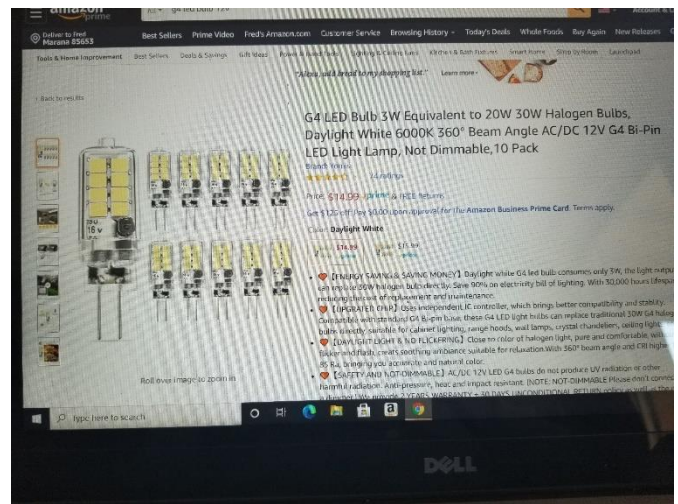
My name is Fred Brooks and I have been requested to bring you technical insight and advice concerning your recreational vehicle. I am a certified RVIA coach technician with 49 years of experience. I joined the Drifters in 2013 after meeting many of you in the course of my employment at Beaudry RV.

I hope this newsletter finds you in good health and as happy as one can be while we deal with the present situation. As you are aware, the Drifters activities have been on hold since our last rally in February "Love is in the air". Now there is something else in the air!

I just want to share a few things with everyone concerning our recreational vehicles. As you know, many of our coaches have been parked for an extended amount of time. Before we use them again, we should spend a few minutes addressing some important safety issues, so we do not experience any interruptions in our adventures. Please check your tire pressures for starters. Next, you should check your house batteries for proper water levels and that the cables are clean of any corrosion. Please check your propane, carbon monoxide, and smoke detectors for proper operation. Also check your fire extinguishers front and rear.

One of the current up-upgrades that many of us have been considering is the interior lighting in our coaches. Most ceiling lighting consist of round flush mount fixtures. These lights have Halogen bulbs that are extremely hot, burn out frequently and require plenty of 12-volt power to illuminate. The current up-grade is to replace these Halogen bulbs with L.E.D. light bulbs. 10 L.E.D. light bulbs require the same amount of power as 1 Halogen light bulb. The L.E.D. light bulbs have a life expectancy of 10,000 hours. They do not put off any measurable heat as

opposed to existing Halogen bulbs. Replacement is also an up-grade that most of us can perform ourselves. The replacement L.E.D. bulbs are available in 2 different colors or hues. The most popular is called "daylight" and have a bright white color. The other choice is called "warm white" and has a slight yellow hue to it and is not as bright. Below is a "screen shot" of the daylight bulbs from Amazon. Please note that the overall length of the replacement L.E.D. bulb cannot exceed 1 3/8" long in order to fit inside the existing light housing.
