OPEN ROADS RV FUEL DISCOUNT PROGRAM



Open Roads is a discount fuel program open to anyone who purchases diesel fuel, whether it be a diesel pickup truck, or an RV. By joining the

program, you will have access to discount diesel prices at specified locations such as Loves Travel Centers of America and many more. Current members are saving 30 to 40 cents per gallon of the pump price. The program is restricted to fuel only at the truck lane at the specified partnership truck fuel centers.

There are no signup fees or membership fees to join. There are no long-term contracts to sign and no hidden fees. Application is free, no credit cards and payment for fuel purchase is made through the member's checking account. Visit

apply.myopenroads.com to join the program. Call 800-275-5089 for information and assistance. I found the staff very friendly and helpful.

I joined the program last fall and have used it several times. On the return from the rally at Apache Junction I used the program at the travel Center of America in Eloy and saved 60 cents a gallon. I highly recommend the program if you are interested in lowering your diesel fuel costs.


